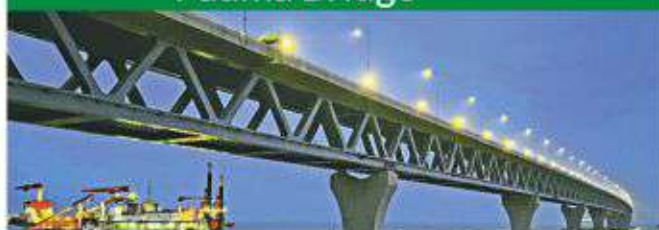

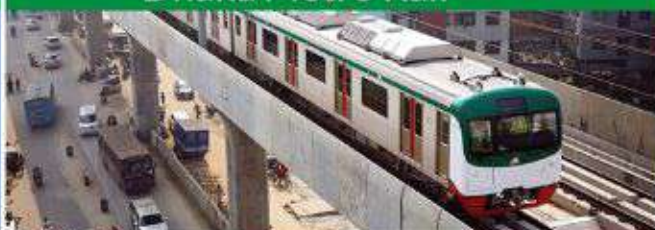

At ICQCC 2026 Dhaka, both local and international examiners will evaluate presentations based on set criteria. All presentations a to e will be considered for **Gold, Silver and Bronze** awards and will receive a digital certificate.

- a. Improvement case studies of QCC:** Presentation by employees of the workshop reporting improvement case studies through Quality Control Circle activities
- b. Improvement case studies for middle-level managers (QIT) :** Presentation by middle-level managers of the workshop reporting improvement case studies through Quality Improvement team.
- c. Promotion case studies of QCC:** Presentation regarding how to effectively promote Quality Control Circle activities, and survey analysis of Quality Control Circle activities.



- d. Total Quality Management (TQM):** Presentation dealing with small group activities under TQM promotion, and/or linked to TQM activities such as Quality Assurance, Policy Management, TPM, Six Sigma, Balanced Score Card etc.
